2022 marked the start of an exciting partnership with La Clinica's *Happy Smiles* program. Every year, this program provides in-school dental education and care to thousands of children.

Students receive annual dental health education and an at-home dental care kit, complete with family education materials. At 28 schools, students receive a dental health screening to identify cavities, determine plaque levels, clean teeth and provide fluoride and sealant treatments as needed. Rogue is proud to help provide these critical preventative dental services to our community.
